The Rt Hon The Baroness Symons of Vernham Dean

Baroness Symons is a senior Labour member of the House of Lords. Formerly Deputy Leader of the House of Lords, she was a Minister in the UK Government from 1997 until stepping down in 2005. Among her government posts she was Minister for the Middle East, Minister for International Trade, Minister for Defence Procurement, and the Prime Minister's envoy to the Gulf.

Baroness Symons is involved with a number of commercial organisations, including roles as a non-executive director of both British Airways and Caparo, and as an adviser to DLA Piper, The CCC Group and Rio Tinto.

She has a wide range of experience, in the Middle East in particular, and currently chairs the UK side of the Saudi-British Joint Business Council, the all party group on Qatar, the British Egyptian Society and is Chairman-Elect of the Arab-British Chambers of Commerce. She is also Vice-president of the Middle East Association and is a board member of British Expertise and the Egyptian British Business Council.
